

Coffee News is first and formost a fun loving easy to read weekly paper with trivia, fun facts and stories from around the world.


The paper also includes placement for advertisment that can be sold on a monthly or quarterly bassis. There were a total of 32 ads per edition that were sold each month.

The paper had a readership of about 17,000 in all of Scottsdale and Tempe, Arizona.


My role in the business came in late 2011 when the family decided to print and design it on their own. I worked as graphic designer on the paper and also as print production specialist overseeing the printing each week until the franchise decided to close in 2014.
